

### Scrappy Hearts Table Runner

15" x 35"

#### **Fabric needed:**

Backing and borders - 1 1/8 yd.  
 Sashing - 1 yd. or 3/8 yd.  
 Red & White scraps for blocks  
 Binding - 1/4 yd.

#### **Cutting**

Red - cut 60 - 2" x 2"  
 Red - cut 15 - 2 3/8" x 2 3/8"; cut in half diagonally to make 30 triangles  
 White - cut 18 - 2" x 2"  
 White - cut 15 - 2 3/8" x 2 3/8"; cut in half diagonally to make 30 triangles

#### *Sashing*

Cut 4 - 1 1/2" x 9 1/2"  
 Cut 2 - 1 1/2" x 31 1/2"

#### *Borders*

Cut 2 - 2 1/2" x 31 1/2"  
 Cut 2 - 2 1/2" x 15 1/2"


*Backing/Batting* 15 1/2" x 35 1/2"

*Binding* - Cut 3 - 2 1/4" x width of fabric

#### **Directions**



1. Stitch the 30 red and white triangles together.
2. The block is made up of 6 rows with 6 squares in each row. Assemble each row. Press seams in the top row to the left, in the 2nd row to the right, etc., alternating each row.
3. Stitch the rows together. Seams may be pressed in either direction.
4. Measure the top to determine the length and width; trim the sashing strips to length, if necessary. Stitch the short sashing strips between and on the ends of the heart blocks, pressing seams toward the sashing. Stitch the long sashing strips to the top and bottom, pressing seams toward the sashing.
5. Measure the top to determine the length and width; trim the border strips to length, if necessary. Stitch the two long borders first, pressing seams toward the border. Finally, stitch the short end borders, pressing seams toward the border.
6. Layer the top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired.
7. Stitch the binding strips together in diagonal seams and bind the quilt.
